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WATERMELON “BUD F1”



Diploid hybrid (with seed) Crimson type. Very healthy and vigorous plant with good fertility and fruit set. The Fruits, oval-shaped, have an average weight of 10 kg, with strong epidermis and a shining and attractive coloring. The flesh, bright red, And Very crispy and HIGH sugar content. Suits very well to the various Environmental and cultivation conditions.

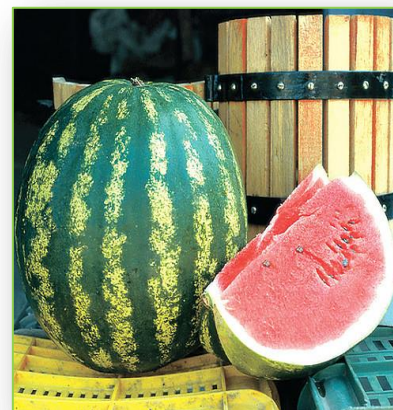
Cycle: 85 days. IR: Fusarium race 1-2, Anthracnose race 1



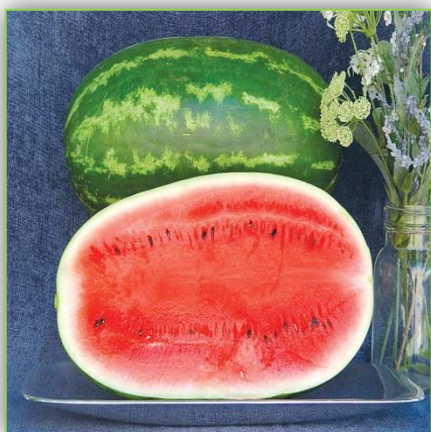
Middle to early variety (85 days). Suitable for long-distance transport. Resistant to Fusarium and to the no.1 strain of Anthracnose. Oval-round fruit, average weight 10-12 Kg depending on the type of soil and cultivation. Light green skin with dark streak. Intense red colored flesh, very sweet. Sowing: from March to May.



WATERMELON “CRIMSON SWEET”



WATERMELON "SCUISIT F1"



It is a diploid hybrid (with seed) and it has a very good production potential. The Crimson Sweet variety is long shaped with a very good sweet taste, a firm and crunchy consistency and a bright red color. It weighs about 12 Kg. The plant tolerates Fusarium breed 1 and 2.

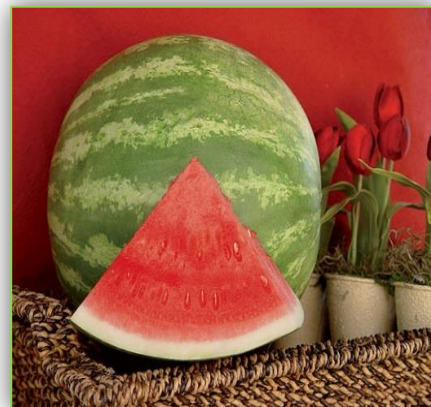


It is a triploid hybrid watermelon (without seed) with round-oval fruits like Crimson, excellent flavor with firm flesh deep red. Average weight of 8 Kg.

Cycle: 90 days. IR: Fusarium race 1-2, Anthracnose race 1.



WATERMELON "DELIS F1"



WATERMELON "SUGAR BABY"



This is a delicious, small fruited "icebox" melon developed specially for home gardens. Fruits grow to 8" (20 cm) across, and weigh about 10 lbs. (4, 5 Kg). The flesh is bright red, fine grained and very flavorful. Plants are small vines producing early enough for short season areas. Sowing: from March to May.





Hybrid with exceptional performance in arid and semi-arid areas. Early California F1 produces on average 10 to 20 spears per plant with a spacing of cm 20x100 between rows. The quality of the spears by color, shape and size has no comparison. Sizes between the 30-35 gr. Produces much earlier than current varieties most well-known and has excellent resistance to Sclerotinia and Latent Virus 2.

ASPARAGUS "EARLY CALIFORNIA F1"



ASPARAGUS "UC 157 F1"



Californian very early clone hybrid, regular and with an excellent presentation. The excellent quality spears are 16/18 mm caliber, with deep green bracts that highly adhere to the spear top. The variety is suitable for under-tunnel or greenhouse growing, for the production of green asparagus in Mediterranean areas, with a hot-dry climate, for the fresh market and for the industrial sector.

Sowing: in rows distant cm 150 one from the other, and 25-30 cm on the row. As bigger is transplanting intensity, as smaller is the diameters of roots. This variety is very requested by professional growers



Basil is an aromatic plant that can be grown in pots or in the open soil. Annual herb widely cultivated for its characteristic aroma and used to flavor many dishes. This variety, well-known and appreciated, has medium-sized, bright green, spoon-shaped leaves with an intense but not minty perfume.

BASIL "ITALIKO"



BASIL "VALENTINO"



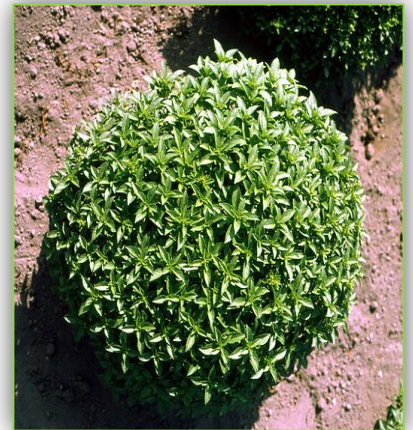
Valentino basil is particularly appreciated for its compact growth, forming a small uniform bush and for its fine large crinkly and drooping, bright green leaves. This variety has a strong aroma without mistiness. It is compact and vigorous in its growth.



A small, compact plant which forms a large, closed sphere with a circumference of 50 – 60 cm. Its small, bright green colored leaves are thin, smooth and have an intense aroma.

SOWING: the seeds can be sown all year round; in small "tunnels" during winter and in the field during spring-summer.

BASIL "GRECO"



BASIL "VIOLETTA"



To be sown all year round: during winter under polythene "Tunnels", in spring/summer in open field. The leaves are dark violet, average size, slightly bubbly and very fragrant.





This stands out from other varieties of basil because of its characteristic thin, smooth bright green leaves that are intensely scented. SOWING: in March in vases or seedbeds, outdoors in rows from April to August.

BASIL "FINE VERDE"



BASIL "GNOMETTO"



Gnometto is the dwarf basil (Genovese type) suitable for growing in pots. Plant dwarf compact, with short internodes, leaves of a beautiful medium green color, medium size. Sowing is done throughout the year, although it's recommended for planting spring-summer cultivations.



This variety differs from others as it is grown not only for its fleshy stems but also for kitchen use as young plants (greens). Erect plant, about 60 cm tall, resistant to early flowering. Leaf stems are whitish-silver, broad and thick. Smooth and slightly crinkly leaves, bright green in color. Suitable for use both as fresh produce and by the frozen food industry. Sowing: from spring to summer in seeds or outdoors.

CHARD "VERDE A COSTA LARGA ARGENTATA"



CHARD "VERDE DA TAGLIO"



Early variety. Smooth, dark-green leaves with small veins. Harvest the whole plant when it reaches 15-20 cm in height. The tender leaves should be cooked before eating.

Sowing: in rows from March to September



Medium-height plant, very compact, whit erects foliage, medium-length oval semi-pointed leaves, smooth and bright green in color, with white medium-sized stems. Ideal variety for autumn-winter cultivation. Sowing: from summer to autumn in seedbeds or directly outdoors.



CHARD "BARESE"



CHARD "VERDE LISCIA INVERNALE"



Compact head with erect bearing. Grows to 60-70 cm and is very resistant to early flowering. Medium-small white stalks and smooth, dark green pointed leaves. The main characteristic of "Bietina di Sarno" chard is that both the stalks and greens can be used. Sowing: from spring to autumn in a seedbed or directly outdoor.

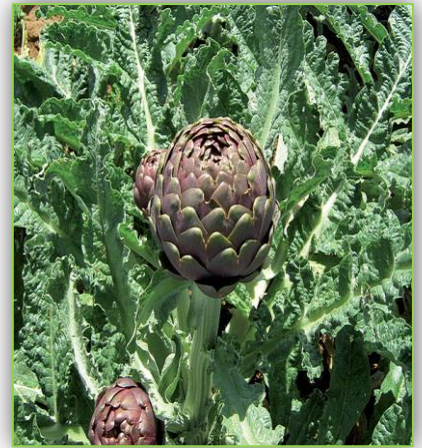




Hybrid of the Romanesco type, medium late growing, high productive and uniform. It produces, green and violet, round-shaped artichokes without thorns best suitable for fresh use. Tender heart and sweet taste. It is sowed in late spring to be harvested at the end of winter/early spring of the following year.

Hybrid created by BHS (Big Heart Seeds) California in collaboration with University of Tuscia.

ARTICHOKE "ROMOLO F1"



ARTICHOKE "ISTAR F1"



Hybrid deflowering, high productive homogeneous in its heads. If heads are harvested during autumn-winter, they show slightly violet shading off on the calyx (see attached). Variety without thorns, very early growth, it ripens much earlier than a normal variety of artichokes. It can be grown as an annual plant. Artichokes are round-shaped, perfect for fresh use. They get slowly open at advanced ripening stage. Very early growth: if seeded in late spring, it starts to produce in November and continuing until following spring.



Hybrid type of "Romanesco" which has good productivity. The corymb has the characteristic form "snail", is green, compact, medium sized and very smooth. It is sown in July-August for harvesting in November-December (autumn average).

CAULIFLOWER "ROMAN F1"



**CAULIFLOWER
"ARTEMIDE F1"**



Hybrid for medium cycle, excellent for autumn-winter crops. Vigorous plant with dark green leaves produces large globe heads, fine-grained, average weight of 1, 5 Kg, well covered leaves. Maturity: gradual 100-110 days after transplanting. Ideal for sowing in July/August and harvesting in November/December.



Violet hybrid variety with a compact, uniform, round head, fine grained, medium sized and medium-low covered. Medium-late variety, it is ideal for sowing in July/August and harvesting in November/December.



**CAULIFLOWER "VIOLET
STAR F1"**



CAULIFLOWER "RN 016 F1"



Its resistance to winter colds means that this plant gives crops of excellent quality. Compact and bulky head that is snow white, bright and protected by large leaves. The plant is erect with good leaf coverage. Compact head and short stemmed. To be sown in July-August for harvesting in January-March.





Hybrid type "Macerata" very smooth, grayish-green leaves, slightly bullate, medium large head, compact and green with medium reliefs. It is sown in July-August for harvesting in December, early January (early winter).

CAULIFLOWER "VERDE F1"



SPROUTING "BROCCOLO RICCIO DI SARNO"



Plant of medium height, heavily branched. Each branch bears a medium-sized green head and average-sized jagged-edge leaves. Early variety with a gradual maturation. To be sowing in June-July for harvesting in November-December.



Very fine grained and resistant to cold. Green Garden is a mid-cycle hybrid variety, maturing approximately 85 day after transplanting. This plant, easy to grow, is suitable for different climatic conditions. The head is of dark gray-green color, compact, well-shaped, 18-20 cm sized and about 400-500 gr in weight. It is suitable for both fresh market and for industry. It produces a large number of tops that re-sprout when cutted. To be sowing in mid-July / early August for harvesting from mid-November to January, or you can sow in October/November for spring harvesting. Suitable for long storage.

SPROUTING "BROCCOLO GREEN GARDEN F1"



**SPROUTING "BROCCOLO
LISCIO CASERTANO"**



Plant medium tall with smooth leaves medium to large. Produces many small sprouts that if you cut grow continuously. It is sown in June-July for harvesting from November.



Medium sized plant with small, narrow and indented leaves. Produces a large number of small tops that re-sprout when cutted. To be sowing from May to August for harvesting from November to March

**SPROUTING "BROCCOLO
SPIGARIELLO RIFIORENTE"**



Remontant variety throughout the year with smooth and bushy leaves. To be sown from July to December.





Early maturity hybrid that produces very few secondary and a globe head of nice bright green color, very compact and it holds well split. Head medium large that if collected immediately weighs 800 gr to 1 kg to up to 1.5 to 2 kg if you procrastinate harvest. Excellent resistance to rot and Alternaria.

Sowing: very flexible sowing from late January to late August. The harvest is made after 50 days from transplant for summer harvesting, and requires about 60 days from transplant for autumn and winter harvesting.

CABBAGE "NFK65 F1"



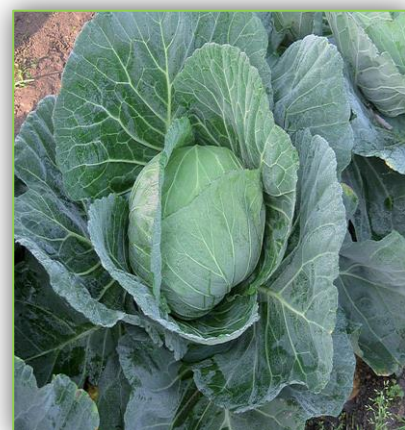
Hybrid variety it can be recommended as an alternative to Precocissimo di Napoli. Very uniform, it matures about 60 days after transplanting. Medium-flat head of 1,6 Kg in weight but it can reach 2,5 Kg when grown under optimal conditions. It is suitable for summer / autumn sowing. It adapts well to high temperatures.



Plant with a short, thin stem and few external leaves. Flattened round head of medium size, greenish-grey in color. It is sown in July for harvesting in autumn or you can sow from August to October for harvesting in late winter and spring.



CABBAGE "PRECOCISSIMO DI NAPOLI"



CABBAGE "AFRICA CROSS F1"



It is a variety very suitable for Mediterranean climate. It can be cultivated all year around and it matures about 70 days after transplanting. It produces a medium sized head, round and very compact.



Hardy plant, cold resistant with large leaf blades, fleshy, dark green and curled at the edges. Excellent for the preparation of soups. Sowing in May-July, the harvest can be done in stages from November to February, before seizing the central peaks, and then the side shoots and finally shoots.

CURLY KALE "TORZELLA"



KOHLRABY "TESTARDO F1"



Medium variety early, semi-erect plant with limited leaf surface. Light green bulb of medium-size and rounded slightly flattened. Resistant to over maturation and bolting. It is sown in July-August with transplant in September-October; the harvest is from December to January.





Mid-early hybrid, for harvesting after 75-80 days from transplantation. Medium-height and very tight ball. Glossy green and high strength leaves. Sowing: it can be sown in summer for autumn-winter harvest.



CHINESE CABBAGE "NOKI F1"



SAVOY CABBAGE "MAGIC BALL F1"



Very early variety, it matures about 80-90 days after transplanting. This cabbage has an average weight of 1,5-2 Kg. Short stem and bullate and intense green leaves. It is suitable for spring crops but it can be sown in summer for autumn harvesting. Be careful to transplant the strongest plants with a good sprout, putting them deeply in the ground.



Typical salad variety, producing deep green cylindrical fruits, 20-22 cm long and with a rounded tip. Firm flesh with few seeds. The plant is an abundant cropper, bearing the first fruits ready for harvesting in 65 days. Nip out main shoot after first four leaves, later repeating the same operation on side shoots. Heavy cropper right from first fruits. Sowing: from March to June.



COUCUMBER "MARKETMORE"



**COUCUMBER "LUNGO
TORTARELLO VERDE SCURO"**



Creeping plant that produces long finely grooved dark green cucumbers that should be harvested when well developed. Very soft with a pleasant taste, they are ideal for salads. SOWING: in open ground in holes 30-40 cm apart in rows spaced 1 meter apart. Place 2 or 3 seeds in each hole, later thinning out the shoots, Plant from March to June and harvest from June until the end of September.



Creeping variety producing long bright green fruits with light ploughings. The fruits tender and with good taste, are perfect for salads, and they can be cropped when the development is completed.

SOWING: in open field, in little holes from March to June, cm 30/40 on the row and cm 100 between rows, using 2/3 seeds per hole, and thinning out after sprout.



**COUCUMBER "LUNGO
TORTARELLO CHIARO"**



**COUCUMBER
"CHINESE SLAGEN"**



Long fruits, deep green skin, soft pulp, crispy, narrow, with few seeds. It is best to prune above the first four leaves and to repeat this operation during the subsequent growth of the shoots. Produces abundantly right from the first cuts. Typical salad variety. Transports well. SOWING: in "stations" on open round between March and June at a distance of 30/40 cm along the row and 1 meter between rows. Use 2/3 seeds for each hole and remember to thin out after sprouting





Erect plant with elongated leaves, whitish ribs and heavily serrated edges. The plentiful shoots at first form a very tight cone. In winter tasty young sprouts grow inside the head. Sowing in summer. To obtain best results July sowings are recommended. Transplant about one month after sowing at intervals of 30 cm, with 40 cm between rows.



CHICORY "CATALOGNA"



CHICORY "DOLCI TALLI"



Long leaves with sharply serrated edges, dark green with thick white ribs. Forms a long, bulky, upright head reaching a height of 40-50 cm.

Can be sown throughout the year except in winter, with successive sowings to extend the harvesting period.



A special variety with a leafy head that forms a compact red ball that is crunchy and firm with an excellent flavor. The plants close to form compact heads, in a similar way to cabbage lettuces. Low temperatures are required in order to achieve bright red, compact balls. Sowing: from June to August.



CHICORY "PALLA ROSSA"



CHICORY "PAN DI ZENZERO"



Large green leaves forming a voluminous elongated head around 40 cm high that turns a white color of its own accord. To be eaten in salads. For vigorous heads, best sown between June and August. Harvest in autumn-winter.



It's an early variety which provides a compact head with long leaves of red and white color. Sowing: to obtain vigorous heads in July-August.



CHICORY "ROSSA DI TREVISO"



CHICORY "ROSSA DI VERONA"



This is a special selection of Rossa di Verona. The plants is very robust, a late variety for January - February harvesting. It forms a large ball that is hard and dense, bright red color with white veins. Excellent level of uniformity when ripe. Sowing: from June to July.





This is short day variety that reaches commercial maturity a month before the Marzatica variety. As well as being an early variety the bulbs, which are white, sweet and tender, keep well. Each bulb weighs about 100 gr and has a diameter of 8 cm. It is an extremely vigorous plant with excellent bearing and dark green foliage. Sowing: ideal for harvesting in February, we recommend sowing in August.

ONION "BIANCA PRECOCISSIMA MARZATICA"



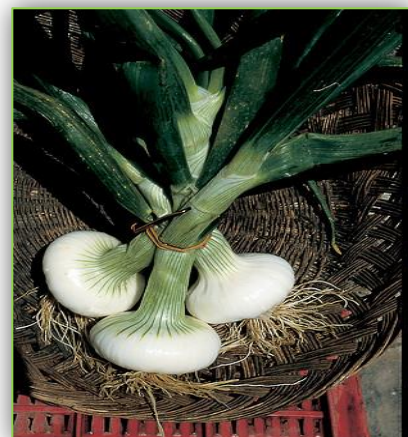
It is a short day variety that produces uniform, flattened round, white bulbs that generally weight 100/120 g each. The leaves are extremely compact, uniform and deep green. Sowing: for best results it is advisable to sow in August for harvesting in March.



An ideal variety for harvesting in April. Produces flattened round, white bulbs that are very uniform and weigh an average of 140-150 gr each. Sowing: from August to the beginning of September.



ONION "APRILATICA"



ONION "BIANCA DI MAGGIO"



An ideal variety for harvesting in May. The plant is very robust and has dark green leaves. It produces flattish-round bulbs that weigh 180/200 gr. Thanks to the robust dark green leaves, this variety is suitable for harvesting in bunches. Sowing: in order to harvest the bulbs in May, sow in September-October.



A late variety. The plant is very vigorous with dark green foliage and produces large, flattened round, white bulbs. Thanks to the excellent bearing of the foliage, this variety is ideal for harvesting in small bunches. Sowing: to avoid pre-flowering, we recommend sowing in October before planting out, or sowing directly outdoors in January-February.



ONION "BIANCA DI GIUGNO"



ONION "AGOSTANA"



This long day variety produces globe-shaped, silvery-white bulbs. For harvesting in August we recommend sowing in late autumn or early spring. Sowing: in late autumn or beginning of spring for a summer production. Can also be used for production of bunching onion if the sowing is made in late-Spring.





A late variety that stores extremely well. Produces a large bulb, shaped like a globe and slightly squashed at both ends. Yellowish outer tunics and white flesh. Sowing: in October. Plant out in January-February and harvest in August. Sow directly outdoors in February.

ONION "GLOBRUNA"



ONION "TROPEA ROSSA ROTONDA"



Vigorous plant with deep green foliage. Medium-late variety. Large round bulb, outer skins a deep wine red, white flesh, tender and sweet. Ideal variety for fresh consumption. Sowing: in autumn for planting out in January-February, or directly outdoors in January-February for summer harvesting.



This is a medium-late, long day variety that produces dark red bulbs that are medium-large and flattened globe-shaped. They store well although they are best suited to eating fresh. Sowing: in Autumn-Spring for summer harvesting. Also suitable for producing red Spring onions.

ONION "ROSSA DI FIRENZE"



ONION "DENSITY"



Variety belonging to the group of "yellow for storage" with round bulb, skin is bronzed yellow color. Ideal for extended storage and industrial processing, as the neck of the bulbs is filled. Sowing in Autumn-Spring, harvested in August.



This is a long day variety although it is fairly early. In fact, about 120 days after sowing in springtime it is ready for consumption. It produces large, yellow, spinning top-shaped bulbs with sweet white flesh. Sowing: in Spring for harvesting in July.



ONION "TEXAS EARLY GRANO 502"



DWARF BEEN "PREGIATO"



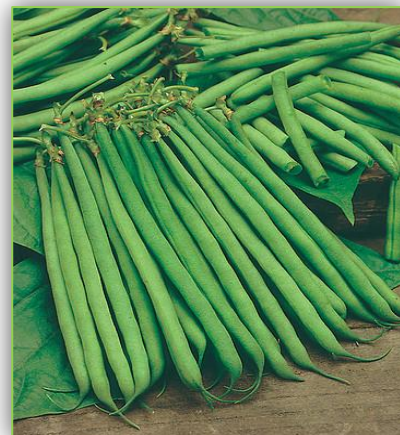
A variety of the latest generation, with high production capacity, ideal for spring sowing both under greenhouse and in open fields but also suitable for late sowing in August - September. Very resistant to common diseases. The dwarf plant stands upright (50-55 cm tall) with non-abundant leaves. The pods, extra-fine, about 15-16 cm long, 0,8 cm diameter, are very tender and have a bright green color. The seeds are white, of small-caliber and do not become apparent on the surface of the pod, not even when ripe.





A middle-late variety that is suitable for the fresh market but is also widely used in the food industry. It can be grown in different environmental conditions, even in hot climates. The plant produces thin, smooth pods that are dark green and uniform and grow 13-14 cm long. Boston is very erect and robust plant and produces enormous quantities of long and tender pods. Sowing: Spring - summer. It has a very long harvesting time.

DWARF BEEN "PARIGINO"



DWARF BEEN "PLATÌ"



A medium precocious variety, "mangiatutto" type exceptional for productivity and taste, as well as for the very tender texture of the pods. Dwarf plant with excellent resistance, good leaf coverage, from green cones, without strings, "mangiatutto", wide, flattened, bright green color. It is sown from March to August in rows at a distance of 40-50 cm. The amount of seeds needed is 85-100 kg/hectare. Harvesting is done in stages 70-80 days from sowing.



Medium early hybrid with head round-globular shape, the average weight is of 600-700 gr. Leaves are medium-high, upright, barrels full and deep green. Vigorous plant with high tolerance to Sclerotinia Sclerotiorum. Very resistant to cold. Sowing: in areas with cold temperature from July 20 to August 10; in areas with mild temperature, the seed can be extended until 15 October. Harvesting takes place after 100-110 days from transplant.

FENNEL "KARINO F1"



FENNEL "SARNO PRECOCE"



Round medium-sized heart that is compact and has thick, fleshy sheaths that are completely white and very sweet flavored. The leaves have erect bearing and full canes. Extremely productive variety, excellent quality and very uniform fruit with very little waste. This variety is characterized by its consistency, and by the fact that it is late to bolt and is very tolerant and resistant to low temperatures. Sowing: from July to August.



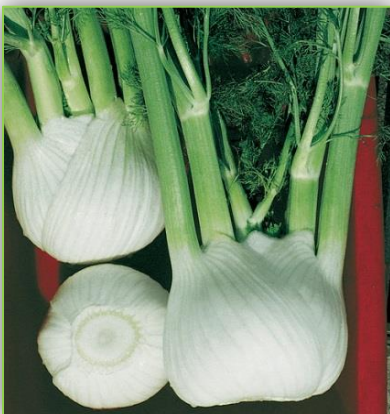
This variety stands out for consistency, slow to bolt. Tolerates and resists low temperatures very well. The hearts are round, of average size, compact with thick, meaty, completely white and low - fiber sheaths. Leaves stand erect, with full canes. Excellent variety in terms of yield, quality and product uniformity. Sowing: in various stages between July and September. Picking can start in November until March.

FENNEL "TARDIVO DI SARNO"



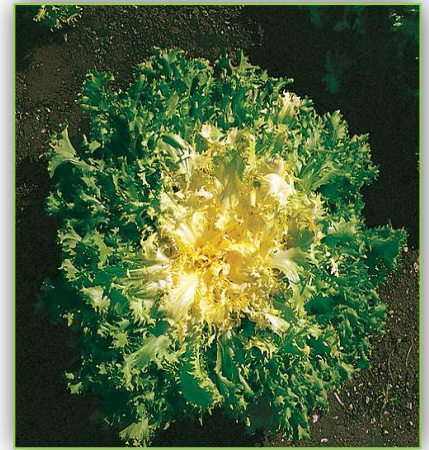
Late variety that is appreciated, very late to bolt. The hearts are large, round, very white and compact. Very thick sheaths that are sweet, crunchy and tender. Medium-tall plant, erect with full cane. Being a late variety (May-June) and given the intense heat of the season, it is advisable to water the soil at least once a week. In this way, the harvest is ensured for the whole month of June and the hearts are crunchy. Sowing: from October to February.





Variety with fine and crisp leaves, uniformly green colored. Compact head, easily blanched, with full, strong yellow heart. Suitable for autumn-winter crop. Sowing: from June onwards

ENDIVE "CAPRICCIO"



ENDIVE "PANCALIERI A COSTA BIANCA"



Suitable for summer and autumn cultivation. Variety with yellow self-blanching heart. Very large head, long mid-green leaves. Fleshy white ribs. The shape of the head facilitates tying up for more intense blanching. Very resistant variety to low temperatures. Sowing: in rows from July to September.



Variety for winter and growth and spring growth with excellent resistance to bolting that allows harvesting to be extended until April-May, when other endive varieties are not available on the market. Late endive variety with finely pointed leaves, external ones light green and inner ones forming a large, compact and very white heart. If cultivated carefully the head can reach a diameter of 45 cm. a few days before harvesting, tie up or cover for blanching. Sowing: from October to January.

ENDIVE "CAPILLINA"



ESCAROLE "GROWERS GIANT"



Endive variety with long leaves and very full heart, compact and self-blanching. A form heads about 40 cm in diameter, with shiny green outer leaves and a white heart. Very crispy, fleshy leaves, with a broad, flat central rib. Good resistance to medium-low temperatures.

Sowing: particularly suitable variety for autumn and winter cultivation. Can be sown from June onwards.

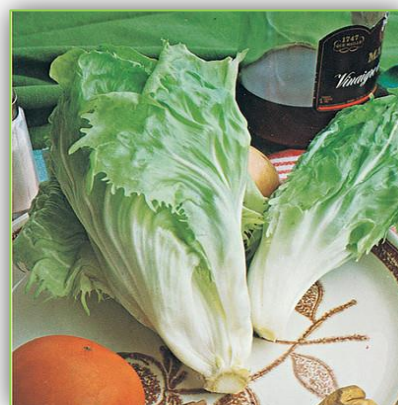


Variety with large, broad and crinkly leaves that curve naturally to form a tall horn-shaped head. Natural blanching. Very resistant to cold. Suitable for autumn cultivation.

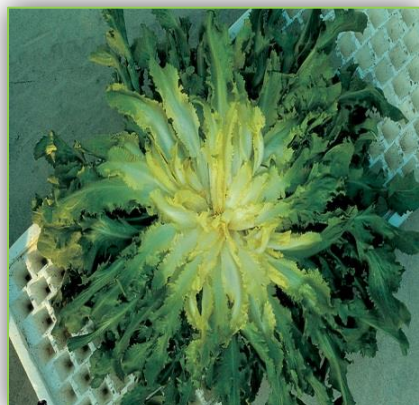
Sowing: in rows from July to October.



ESCAROLE "CORNETTO DI BORDEAUX"



ESCAROLE "RICCIA SCHIANA"



Suitable for summer and autumn cultivation. Uniform plants with large, full head of greenish-yellow leaves, crisp and with medium-serrated edges. Erect growth with broad white ribs. A few days before harvesting the head should be tied or covered to promote blanching.

Sowing: from July to October.





Ideal variety for summer-autumn cultivation. Large head, bright green leaves, very crispy. Sowing: from May to September.

ESCAROLE "CENTOFOGLIE VANAFRANA"



ESCAROLE "PAPAREGNA"



Winter variety, very resistant to bolting, making it very suitable for late harvesting in April-May. Bulky head with full yellow heart, broad leaves, crispy, fairly smooth and medium-green in color. The head, which weighs about 1 kg, has an excellent appearance, and is very tender and crisp. Sowing: october-december.



Large-sized plant, mid-green in color. Voluminous and firm head, 35-40cm. diameters. It weighs about 1kg, the inner leaves are upright, while the outer ones are elongated and blanch easily. This variety is suitable for spring - autumn cultivations. Sowing: it can be sown from July to December.

ESCAROLE "FULL HEART"

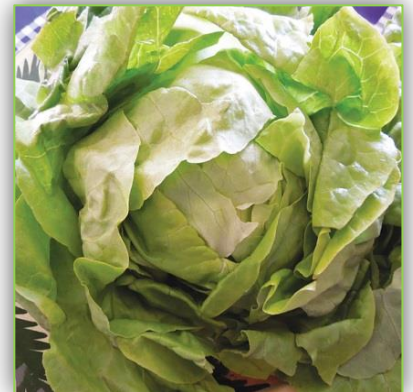


Particularly suitable variety for spring and summer cultivation. Broad, rounded leaves. Dark green outer leaves, inner forming a large compact heart that promotes natural blanching. Plants about 35-40 cm in diameter. Excellent resistance to heat and bolting.



Vigorous plant, with abundant, light green and shiny foliage. Voluminous, compact and heavy head. Healthy and well-formed bottom. Bremia and Lettuce Mosaic virus resistant. Summer cycle variety. It can be sown from March to August.

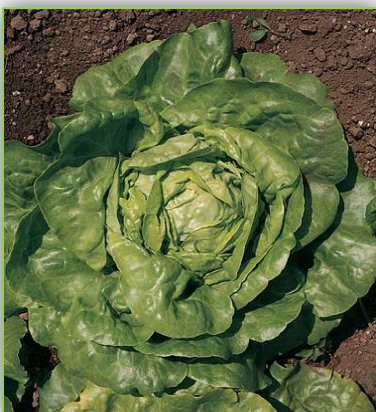

LATTUCE "IMPERIAL WINTER"



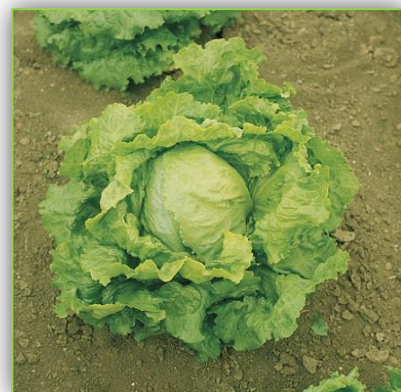
Suitable for cultivation in greenhouses or outdoors. Compact, bulky head resistant to Bremia, high tolerance to Lettuce Mosaic. Sowing: from September to February.



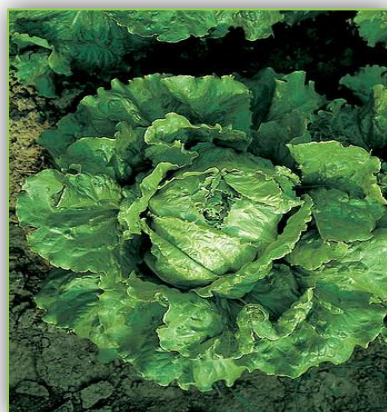


Ideal for spring and summer cultivation. White seeds, large compact head, slightly crinkly leaves, yellowish-green in color and very crispy. Robust plant very resistant to stem rot. The heavy, tightly closed head and the well-formed base make this variety ideal for both domestic and export markets. Medium tendency to bolt. Sowing: from February to August.

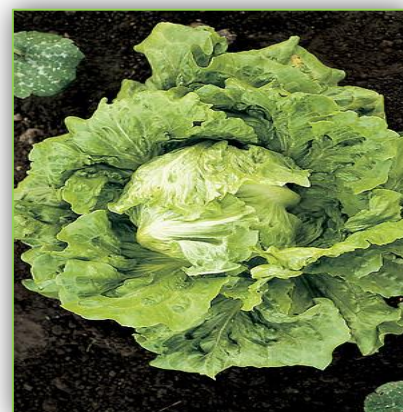


A summer-autumn variety with wavy wrinkled external leaves which have slightly jagged edges. Bright green on the outside and paler on the inside, with a very tight and particularly crunchy medium-sized head. Its exceptional hardiness and vigor make it suitable for growing in a wide range of areas. To be cut when the head is full and compact. SOWING: to be sown in seedbeds between August and October. When the plants have 4-5 leaves they should be replanted 30-40 cm apart in rows spaced 30-40 cm apart.

The fruit , which is an elongated-cylindrical shape and weighs approx. 70 gr., has an excellent color and is very uniform. This variety is particular suitable for consuming fresh. Variety best suited to beige sown broadcast. SOWING: variety best suited to being sow broadcast. Can be sow in a nursery from January to April.





Firm, determinate and very productive plant. It is suitable both for open field cultivation and under tunnel. Its yellow fruits are small, oval of 3 cm diameter, very firm and with a particular flavor. They weigh about 15 gr. Harvest can take place 60 days after transplantation; fruits can be preserved for a long time. Res/ Toll: Vo - Fol:1 - M.*

Hybrid, oval-squared shape variety, Jointless type. Determinate, medium-early, firm and very productive plant. It produces oval- shaped and deep red fruits of about Gr.100; they are characterized by thick flesh. Good to be skinned, high viscosity and high resistance to over-ripening. High brix. Suitable for production of tomatoes and / or preserved but is also used for the fresh consumption.



The fruit is squared and medium-sized with good consistency and color. This is a compact plant of average size with good foliage cover. With concentrated and early maturity, the Rio Grande is ideal for mechanical harvesting. This variety has demonstrated an optimum suitability for a variety of areas. It has a strong resistance to Verticillium and fusarium. We recommend very limited use of azote for mechanical harvesting.

The fruit are olive – shaped and weigh 25-30 grams. They are easy to pick and pack. For these reasons they are perfect for mechanical harvesting and hardly suitable for the canning industry.

Sensitive to cold, preferring cool and fertile soil rich in organic substance. Very vigorous plant with broad, deep green leaves and a medium aroma. Grows back rapidly and repeatedly after cutting. Sowing: broadcast from February to September using about 20 gr of seeds for 10 sq. meters of surface area. The seed takes about one month to germinate.



Dwarf variety with short, finely serrated, crinkled and pleasantly scented bright green leaves. Excellent for both seasoning and decorating dishes. Sowing: from March to October. Scatter approximately 20 gr of seeds over 10 sq. meters of surface area. The seed takes about one month to germinate.

Medium-sized plants with aromatic dark green medium-sized leaves. Early variety that grows back rapidly and repeatedly after cutting. Good resistance to cold. Sowing: sow broadcast from March to October using about 20 gr of seeds for 10 sq. meters of surface area. The seed takes about one month to germinate.



New selection with strongly jagged leaf with an intense flavor. It is particularly appreciated for Baby Leaf productions for its precocity, the yield and the high percentage of dry substance, which also makes them both resistant to manipulations and intact after the several stages of processing.

This is herbaceous plant found in the wild in Italy. It is quite short and thin, smooth leaves which are bright green in color and have an intense aroma. Owing to its strong but pleasant flavor. The plant grows well in any type of soil and requires little care. Sowing: it should be bedded out by hand, from March to October and should be protected during the winter months by plastic sheeting.





Erect medium-height plant with tightly packed stalks. Bright green leaves and full, rounds stalks, very tender and easy to blanch. Can also be sown under protected cultivation for winter harvesting. Transplant when seedlings are about 15-20 cm tall, at a distance of 50 cm with 25 cm between rows. To promote growth after transplanting prune foliage and roots.

CELERY "VERDE DA TAGLIO NAPOLETANO"



Country variety, hardy and highly resistant to the cold. Regenerates quickly after cutting. Vigorous and resistant plant with very pleasant fragrance.



Cylindrical club-ended fruits measuring up to 60 cm in length and weighing on average between 15-20 Kg. outer green skin with grey stripes and deep orange pulp containing very few seeds. Sowing: from April to July.

Plant with very short distance between side-sprouts, green fully lobed leaves with whitish markings. Very long fruits, mid-green with lighter streaks. Sowing: from April to June.

Annual, herbaceous plant that grows to height of 40-80 cm. thin stalks that are branched at the tip, hollow, streaked and smooth. Its green-greyish blue leaves alternate with sheaths and capillary lacinia. Flowers in June-July. SOWING: from March to May in rows 30-40 cm apart.



HERBS "DILL"



HERBS "BORAGE"



The annual herb grows to a height of 50 cm. It has oval- shaped leaves which are approximately 5 cm from stem to tip and 10 cm wide. The leaves lower down the plant are slightly bigger. It is in bloom from May to summer. The flowers grow sporadically towards the top of the plant forming a panicle. The corolla, which has red buds, turns light blue after blooming. SOWING: in spring and autumn for Mediterranean climates.





Annual herbaceous plant 30-50 cm tall, with striped, hairless fruits. The root is bundled. The inflorescences are on the head, united in corymbs, supported by a long stalk, with yellow flowers, tubular, hermaphrodite at the center and white flowers, strap-shaped, female in distal position. Blossoms between May and August. SOWING: normally take place in summer. Because this species is distinguished by a short growth cycle (about 50 days) it can also be planted in spring.



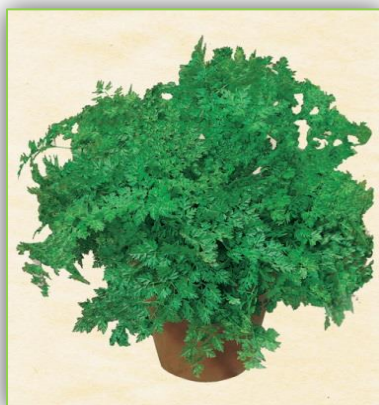

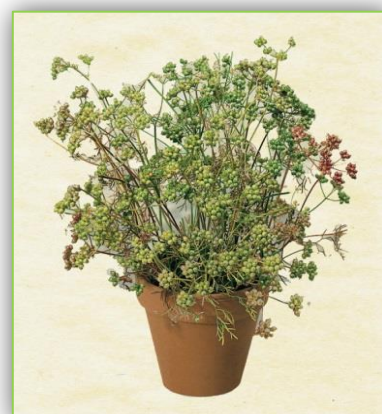
This is an annual, herbaceous plant, similar to parsley. It has a furry, branched stalk and grows to a height of between 40 – 80 cm. The leafed plant has white flowers which have five petals each and are bunched together in groups of 3 – 5. SOWING: the seeds can either be bedded out from March to September or during winter in large pots in a heated greenhouse. Harvesting can start 6-10 weeks after sowing.



Annual herbaceous plant, 30-70 cm tall. The stem is straight, cylindrical, much branched, green, and often reddish. The flowers are minuscule and the corolla has five white or pink bilobate petals. SOWING: in spring, in March-April, placing the seed at a depth of 1,5-2,5 cm. The optimal germination temperature fluctuates between 20 and 23° C.



HERBS "CORIANDER"



HERBS "CRESCIONE"



Aquatic plant that is frequently found along the banks of rivers or ponds. This plant is used as an aromatic, for its edible leaves and as medicinal. The leaves are round and the flowers white in color. SOWING: in spring in a loose substrate.



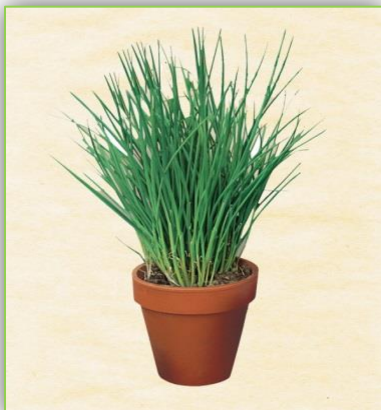
It's an annual herbaceous plant, 30-50 cm high, with pressed fruit, glabrous. The root is sorted. The flowers are grouped in corymbs head, supported by a long stalk, with yellow flowers, tubular, hermaphrodite in the center and white flowers ligulae female distal position. It blooms from May to August. SOWING: suitable for spring cultivation but it also can be sown in summer because this plant has a short growth cycle (about 50 days).



HERBS "DANDELION"



HERBS "CHIVE"



Chive is an aromatic, perennial plant. It forms a head of small leaves and in spring numerous pink or mauve ornamental flowers. The onion-flavored leaves are cylindrical, short and blue-green in color. SOWING: in greenhouse from February to April.

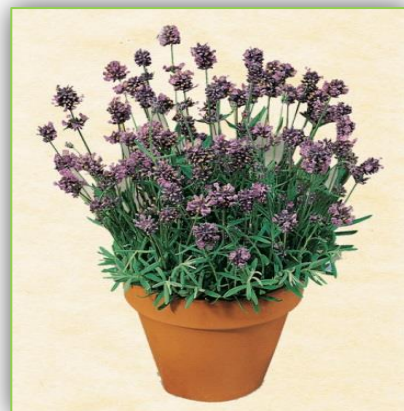




This plant grows to a height of between 40-100 cm and the stem has many branches, the younger of which are herbaceous, quadrangular and are covered with a thin grey pubescence similar to the leaves which are sessile and are opposed on the plant. The flowers are light blue in color, small and form small bunches. It flowers from June to July. The crop lasts from 6 to 10 years. SOWING: in spring and summer for Mediterranean climates.



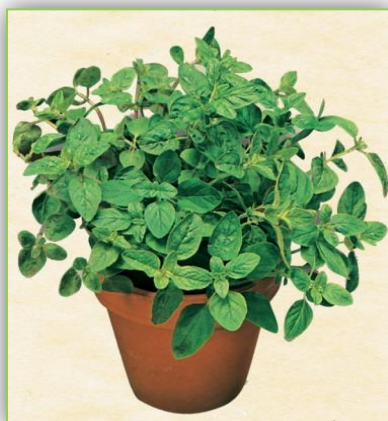
HERBS "LAVENDER"



HERBS "MARJORAM"



Marjoram is a suffrutex that grows to a height of 40-50 cm. The stem is pubescent, quadrangular and branched with opposing, small oval leaves that are a grayish color and tormentors. The roots are fascicled and slender. The flowers are sessile and are white with shades of red. They are grouped together in spike-shaped inflorescences on the tips of the secondary branches. Cultivation in our environments lasts between 4-5 years. Marjoram is widely used in cooking to flavor dishes. Furthermore, it has digestive and diuretic properties. SOWING: directly at the end of March.

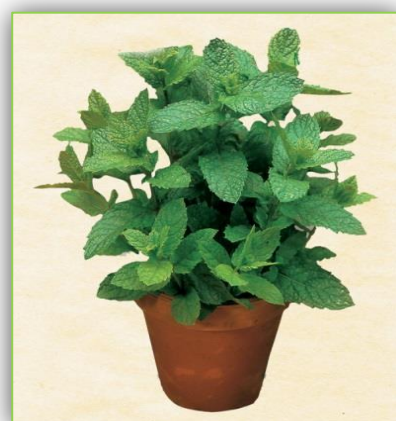


Melissa is an herbaceous perennial, 50-90 cm tall. It has branched, erect, quadrangular stems. The leaves are oval and serrated and grow opposed on the plant. The flowers (which are either red or white) grow near the steam of the leaves. The crop usually lasts 4-5 years but does very occasionally last up to 8 year.

SOWING: is used sown towards the end of winter in a greenhouse (heated to a temperature of 20-25 °C during the first 3 weeks and 12-16 °C thereafter). Transplant in May or June.

HERBS "PEPPERMINT"



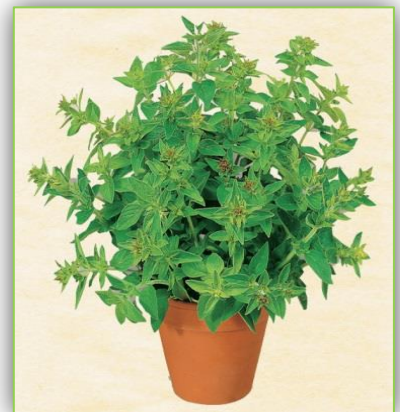
Peppermint is an herbaceous plant, 50-60 cm tall and has a branched, fibrous root. Its branched stem is quadrangular, upright and is either green or violet in color. The leaves are serrated and opposed on the plant. The flowers are either rose-violet or whitish in color and are almost always sterile. They group together on small spikes protruding from the plant which flowers in July. SOWING: in spring and autumn for Mediterranean climates.



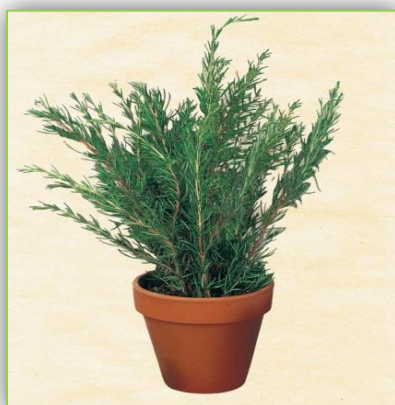
Oregano is a perennial and can reach a height of 50 cm. The reddish-colored stem tends to have few branches or thorns. The oval-shaped leaves (2-3 cm by 1,5 cm) have short stalks which are approximately 1 cm long. The leaves are occasionally serrated. Its small flowers are bunched closely together and form flat panicles. The plant's aroma varies depending on where it is cultivated: the oregano grown in southern Italy (widely used as seasoning), has a much stronger aroma than the oregano grown in northern Italy. SOWING: during the spring in open field or in seedbeds from July to August for transplanting in October-November.



HERBS "OREGANO"



HERBS "ROSMARY"



This evergreen shrub, which grows to a height of almost 1 m, has sweet-smelling leaves and upward-growing branches. During the fine season, it is almost always in bloom. The upper lip is whole or with three small teeth. The interior is divided into two long teeth. The corolla is light violet in color. There are two protrusions which protrude from the corolla. SOWING: during the spring and autumn.



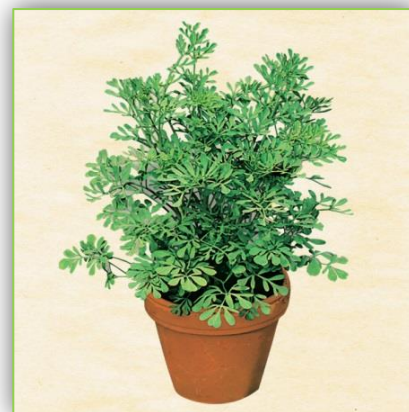


Perennial plant originating in Southern Europe, up to 80 cm tall. Branched stem and yellow-greenish flowers. The leaves are collected before flowering and can be used fresh or dried.

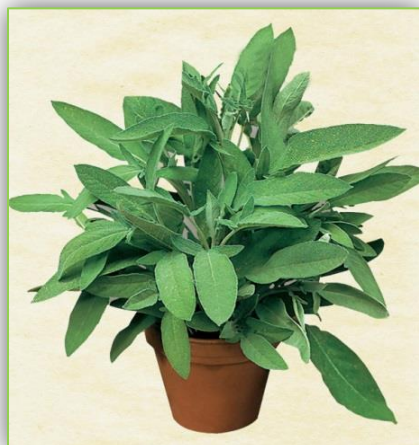
SOWING: in spring, transplanting the potted seedlings into the open field, in a sunny place.



HERBS "RUE"



HERBS "SAGE"



Sage grows a height of between 50 and 60 cm. It is completely pubescent and has a quadrangular, branched stalk. Its leaves are 7-8 cm long and have a rough surface with serrated edges. The leaves growing further up plant are small and deciduous. The roots are tightly bunched together. The tubular flowers grows closely together with between 5 and 10 flowers per bunches. They are either light violet or pink in color. SOWING: the seeds can be field-sown in April or can be planted in a greenhouse towards the end of winter.

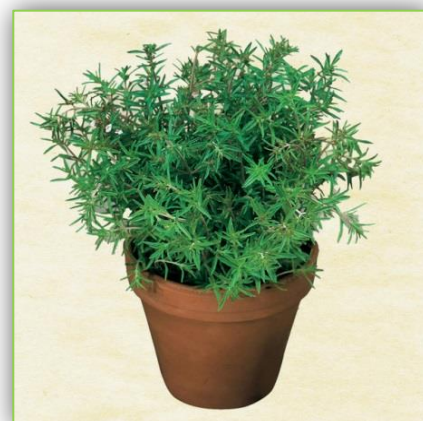


Summer savory is a perennial aromatic plant typical of the Mediterranean area. It reaches a height of about 40-60 cm and blooms at the height of summer. The flowers, a pale pink color, emit a pleasant aroma.

SOWING: in a seedbed at the end of winter. The seedlings must then be transplanted in rows 50-60 cm apart.



HERBS "SUMMER SAVORY"



HERBS "THYME"



Thyme grows to a height between 20 and 50 cm. The leaves are pointed, have curved edges and are grey-green in color. The flowers are small, tubular and are red-violet in color. They group together where the leaves join the stem.

SOWING: the seeds should be sown in a greenhouse during March; the plant is in blossom from June to September.



It's an early very good seed variety, producing middle size fruits start sprouting in the beginning of summer. This plant puts out a huge number of stolons, and it could be also cultivated as a climbing variety. It produces abundantly and continuously from beginning of summer until end of autumn. For early crops sow at the end of Summer- beginning of autumn in protected ambient. When the plants reach an average height of 10-15 cm transplant in open field or in pot.
